

MOTION TO CHANGE ARTICLE 22.2 and ARTICLE 22.3 OF THE CONSTITUTION and BYLAW #10

Whereas the current Montreal Basketball League (MBL) Constitution and Bylaws with regards to player transfers doesn't stipulate a specific deadline for players to request a written release from their current organization.

And to eliminate any possibility for players to request a written release after participating in summer activities provided by other MBL organizations/clubs (i.e., travelling teams, skills camps, etc...).

We propose to revise the current Article 22.2 and Article 22.3 of the MBL Constitution and MBL By-Law #10 by adding a player transfer request deadline that would coincide with the end of the MBL season and the beginning of the Summer activities/program.

Proposed revision:

Article 22.2 / Article 22.3 of the MBL Constitution and Bylaw #10

- Player cannot transfer from one organization to another within the MBL. They must sit-out one full season and then a transfer may be granted by the league.
- A player wishing to transfer to another organization at the end of the season must request from his current organization/team a written transfer before April 30th. Any transfer request after April 30th will be automatically denied. It is up to each organization to inform their players of this bylaw.
